


Youth Cancer Europe Company Profile

Youth Cancer Europe (YCE) is a patient organisation made up of a network of half a million European youth affected by cancer and youth cancer organizations from 31 different European countries. YCE speaks the language of young adults, promotes research and fights for better access to care, better treatments and conditions and helps reduce disparities across Europe for young people with cancer.

YCE is a very young organization, our first General Assembly took place in 2017 and since then, we had done lots of policy work advocating for the most relevant unmet needs of youth cancer patients in Europe.



Youth Cancer Europe's **White Paper** was launched in 2018 in the European Parliament, where YCE brought financial discrimination into focus and addressed **The Right to be Forgotten** law for the first time in front of EU lawmakers.

Other priorities on top of YCE's agenda are access to cross-border healthcare, fertility preservation and mental health.

Youth Cancer Europe is part in several **EU projects**, making sure young people with lived cancer experience are present from the beginning when setting any kind of agenda for research and policymaking in Europe, to ensure that priorities are in line with patients' priorities.

Since the very first days of the **conflict in Ukraine**, Youth Cancer Europe **provide humanitarian services** and advocate for the needs of Ukrainian cancer patients.
